

Mind Mapping Competition 2024

Rules and Regulations

Categories:

- Category A: Participants aged 5 to 12 years old
- Category B: Participants aged 13 and above

Competition Structure:

- Each category consists of two sections: Mind Mapping from a Written Text and Free-Style Creative Mind Map.
- Participants must complete both sections in their respective categories.

Section 1: Mind Mapping from a Written Text (1 hour)

- Participants summarise an article in Mind Map form.
- Mind Maps must adhere to Buzan Mind Mapping laws and be visually attractive.

Section 2: Free-Style Creative Mind Map (1 hour)

- Participants create a Mind Map on a topic of their choice, following Buzan Mind Mapping laws.
- Creativity is encouraged, and competitors may use any media on A3 paper.

Buzan Mind Mapping Laws:

1. Start in the centre of a blank landscape page (A3 size art paper).
2. Use an image or picture for your central idea.
3. Utilise colours throughout.
4. Connect main branches to the central image and subsequent levels.
5. Use curved branches.
6. One keyword per line.
7. Incorporate images throughout.

Important Notes:

- Answer sheets will be provided.
- Participants must bring writing materials such as pens, colour pens, textures, crayons, colour pencils, marker pens, etc.
