Category A (Participants age 5 to 12)

2.00pm – 3.00pm **Section 1: Mind Mapping from a Written Text (1 hour)**
(Participants are given an article and are required to summarise it in Mind Map form. The Mind Map must accurately capture all key points in this text)

3.00pm – 3.15pm BREAK TIME

3.15pm – 4.15pm **Section 2: Free-Style Creative Mind Map (1 hour)**
(Participants create a Mind Map on a subject of their own choice. Credit will be given for creative expression within the Mind Map Laws. Competitors may use any media on A3 paper to create their Mind Map featuring marker pens, textures, crayon colours, colour pencils, colour pens, 3D visualisation, etc.)

Category B (Participants age 13 and above)

2.00pm – 3.00pm **Section 1: Mind Mapping from a Written Text (1 hour)**
(Participants are given an article and are required to summarise it in Mind Map form. The Mind Map must accurately capture all key points in this text)

3.15pm – 4.15pm **Section 2: Free-Style Creative Mind Map (1 hour)**
(Participants create a Mind Map on a subject of their own choice. Credit will be given for creative expression within the Mind Map Laws. Competitors may use any media on A3 paper to create their Mind Map featuring marker pens, textures, crayon colours, colour pencils, colour pens, 3D visualisation, etc.)

1. Answer sheets will be provided. You will receive 2 pieces of A3 size drawing papers in a plastic sheet. Please submit both A3 drawing papers in the same plastic sheet at the end of the competition for collection by the invigilator.
2. All participants are required to bring along writing materials such as pencils, pens, colour pencils, eraser, colour pens, marker pens, textures, inks, crayon and etc. for the competition. Water based materials are not allowed.
3. Participants of the Mind Mapping Competition Category A and Category B must complete all 2 sections.
